SRB collects a record Rs11.75b in Dec

KARACHI. The Sindh Revenue Board made a record revenue collection of Rs11.75 billion in December 2020, according to a statement issued by the SRB on Thursday. This is the highest collection in a month by the SRB in any first half of the financial year since 2011-12, read the statement. In December 2019, the SRB collected 9.39b, indicating a comparative growth of 25 per cent. During the first half of the financial year 2020-21, the SRB collected RS57.02b as compared to RS49.2b in the same duration of the financial year 2019-20, indicating a revenue growth of 16 per cent.
