

The petitioner is a Custom Agent. Action was taken against him on the basis of the goods declared without paying the tax. The Order-In-Original was passed against the petitioner on 9.04.2014, whereas appeal against such order was filed on 8.06.2014 i.e. after 60 days. The period for filing appeal is 30 days. The appeal was dismissed. The delay was not condoned. The counsel for the petitioner in paragraph 4 of the petition stated that he was ill. He has not explained the delay and only general plea of sickness has been raised. He placed reliance on the case reported in 2003 PTD 1329. The petitioner ought to have given sufficient reasons for delay, which he failed to do. We find no justification to interfere with the order passed by the Appellate forum. This petition is dismissed in limine.
